Abstract: 2 tools to help students with their Listening

A webinar to introduce you to an online course "How to understand British Spoken English" and a Podcast, "English Waffle" both aimed at helping your students develop listening skills and spoken fluency.

Maybe your students are pretty good at reading and expressing themselves, but when it comes to understanding real, fast English they often find it more difficult. How can we help bridge the gap between slow scripted conversations and real-life, messy spontaneous English? In my online course, I suggest a range of practice activites that can actively improve your students understanding of real English and share teaching strategies that can help unlock this often termed "Cinderella" skill.
